The Holy Week Calendar will help your family to focus on the week and the significance. Each day, beginning with Palm Sunday, you will be able to read a short portion of the scriptures and work on a related craft to remember the events that led to Christ's death and resurrection.

## Sunday

TOPIC: Palm Sunday

READING: Mark 11:1-11 and Luke 19:28-44

MEMORY VERSE: "Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" Mark 11:9

CRAFT: construction paper palm leaves. See the following example:



## Monday

TOPIC: Jesus Clears the Temple

READING: Mark 11:12-17

MEMORY VERSE: "My house shall be called a house of prayer for all nations." Mark 11:17/Isaiah

CRAFT: construction paper table cutout with pennies (coins) taped. See the following example:



## Tuesday

TOPIC: Teaching at the Temple

READING: Luke 19:47-48

MEMORY VERSE: "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path." Psalm 119:105

CRAFT: scrolls made out of paper and two sticks. See the following example:



### Wednesday

TOPIC: Praying for Anything and Remaining Watchful

READING: Mark 11: 20-26, 13:32-37 and Luke 21:34-36

MEMORY VERSE: "Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be ours." Mark 11:24

CRAFT: trace child's hands to represent praying hands; watchtower or eye to represent remaining watchful. See the following examples:





### Thursday

TOPIC: Communion, Garden of Gethsemane, Judas' Betrayal

READING: Mark 14:17-26, 32-35, 43-50 and Luke 22:14-23, 39-53

MEMORY VERSE: "Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me, yet not my will, but yours be done." Luke 22:42

CRAFT: construction paper cutout of goblet; sack of coins. See the following examples:



### Friday

TOPIC: The Cross

READING: Mark 15:16-39 and Luke 23:26-49

MEMORY VERSE: "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing." Luke 23:34

CRAFT: 3 popsicle stick crosses. See the following examples:



### Saturday

TOPIC: Laid in the Tomb

READING: Mark 15:42-47 and Luke 23:50-56

MEMORY VERSE: "[Joseph] came from...Arimathea and he was waiting for the kingdom of God." Luke 23:51

CRAFT: construction paper tomb and stone. Se the following examples:



**Resurrection Sunday**

TOPIC: Resurrection

READING: Luke 24:1-12

MEMORY VERSE: "He is not here; he has risen!" Luke 24:6

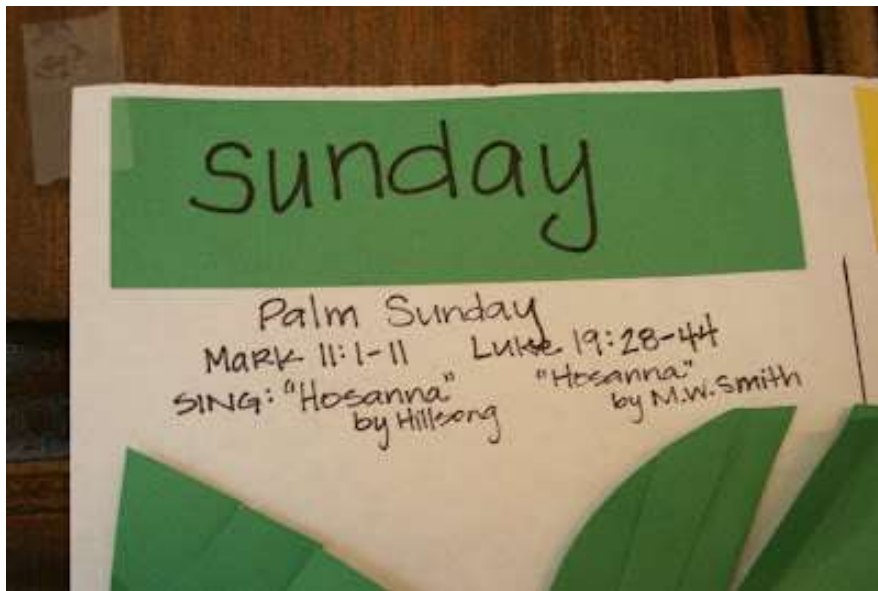
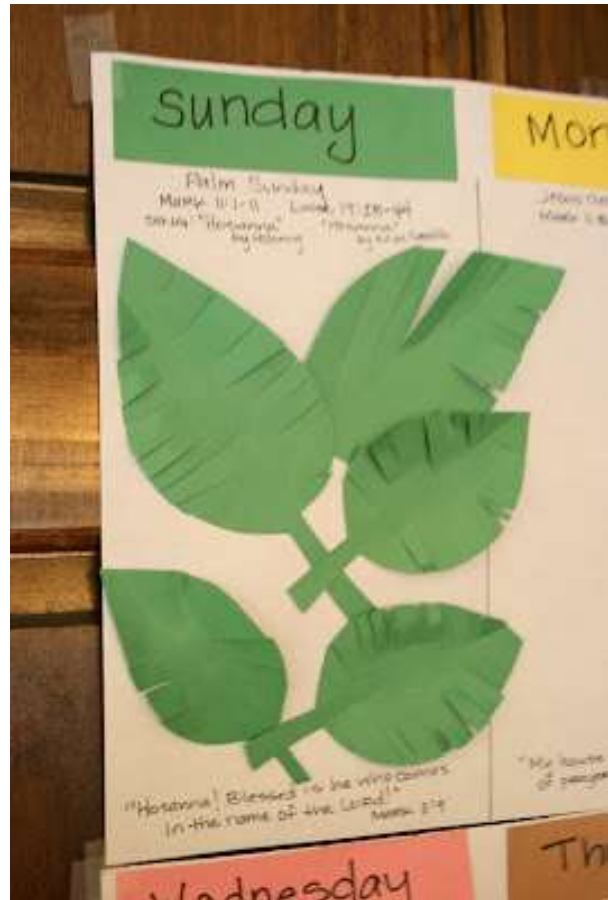
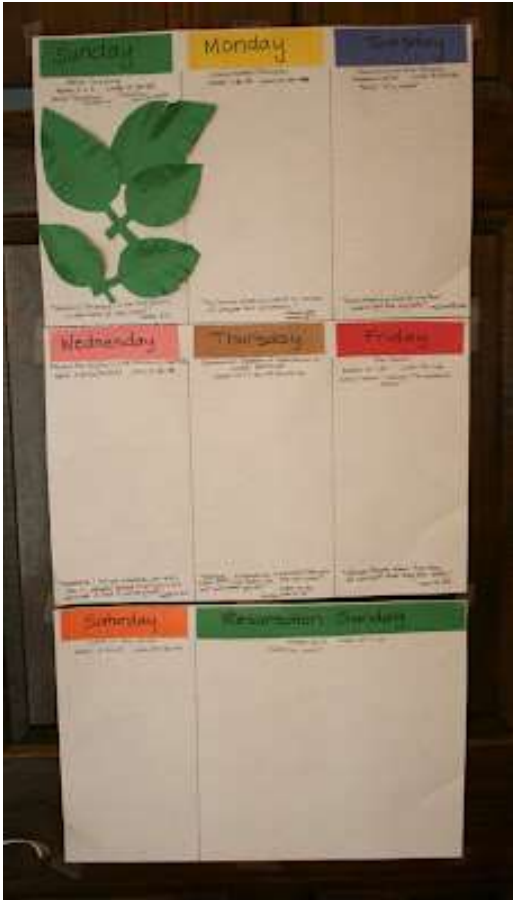
